COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION STRATEGY

The restoration of dignity amongst all Africans while we building a legacy for our future redeemed generational inheritance and prosperity. Ultimately, honouring and utilizing individuals (*created in God's image*) within the **family structure** (*influence circle*) through **participation in governance**.

The picture below is known as the Community Chest Circles Association platform to **reflect a creation of an inclusive process, inviting the participation of every citizen** in the country to **exersize** his/her skills as a gift to society at the nearest Community Care Centre or Skills Village. The start-up process will focus on collaboration and unity **within a ward** between citizens, service delivery, job creation, youth development, enterprise development, **economic participation** and the rebuilding of relationships. The main focus being, stewardship of resources from within a **family circle of influence** that **flows out** and extends **towards governance**. **This process of collaboration and unity within a ward or county will automatically create stability and enhance** the process of **mutual respect, healing and trust in all relationships thereby teaching** their children and their children's children about safety, security and their **Redeemed Family Inheritance** (legacy). A **Community Command Centre** in every ward will upload all activities related to safety and security towards food, soil and feed on behalf of the farming community.

TOP (of picture): Creation started with **one family appointed and instructed by our Creator to protect, manage (rule and reign) over creation on His behalf. Thereby taking notice that** our family structure with our children and their children is placed **at the TOP (of picture) of creation's priority list** to ensure that **respect and ethics** are taught in **every family**. To ensure smooth implementation planning, we start a ward with at least 10 Family Chests to form a **community task team** that will implement this instruction from **The Creator**.

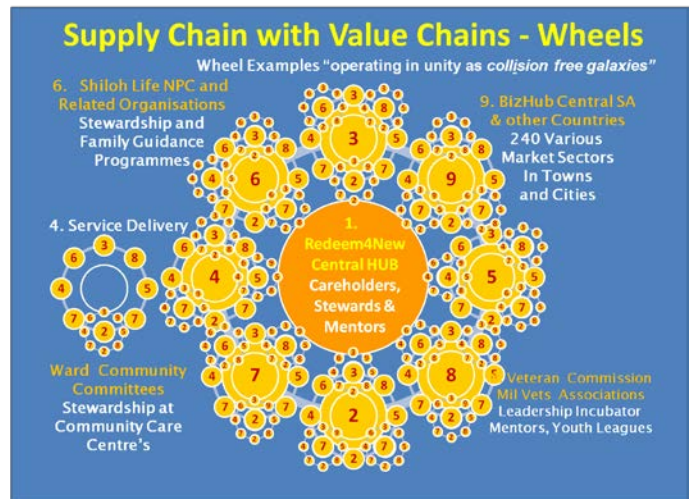
Through these structures it then further plays out into Schools, Colleges, Universities and Skills Villages whereby **Church facilities could also be utilised** as well as Community Care Centres. **Thereby forming and establishing the concept of a strong and solid Community Structure.** All these institutions can collectively be described as our **Family Chest Educational Structures** that focusses on the educational aspects within the community for **educating all** our children and students in becoming shareholders of the Community banking platform with interest free loans.

RIGHT (side of picture):

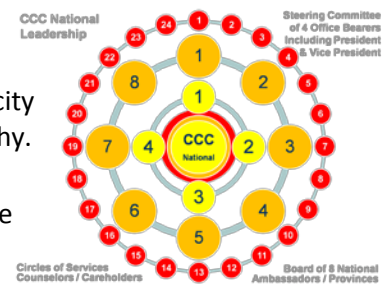
PHASE 1.A An INTRODUCTION PHASE (within 90 days of starting date for implementation)

Identify your 10 Family Chests and Community Builder groups for the various market sectors as indicated from the right-hand section of the picture on the previous page. Those that have accepted to move towards the central neutral position on the picture, as an A-political family task team of at least 10 stewards, with a servant heart to focus on the most urgent issues in their ward, **such as; Service Delivery**. As a suggestion, these stewards might have interests in the churches (CBOs), community policing forum (CPF), CCCA ward Community Committee (non-political), social service, co-operatives, military veterans, NGOs, street committees and youth organisations.

1. This will be known as the **C3 Ward / County Community Task Team** (Stewards) to identify the other local stewards in the ward to participate as stewards such as; a) Business Chamber stewards b) ward councillors for mayoral special community projects c) **Educational Stewards** and d) a **Proposed Veteran Community Desk** office for stewards at local government facilities, **directly accessing all market sectors** in support of the municipality and collective governance through **Community Courts** in every ward / county.
2. The CCCA town/city Founder/Steward together with a CCCA Ambassador will **present** the first presentation to this group to ensure full disclosure of **all content** and answer all appropriate questions.
3. CCCA Ward **Community Task Team** will identify and appoint registered Family Chest Founders as Stewards for a specific market sector to form part of the Ward Community Task Team. A CCCA **Community Chest Ambassador** will collaborate to prepare the rollout plan with **appointed Founders** of the Family Chests to be ready for the **Public Participation Project Plan (PPPP) and announce the date of commencement.**
4. **Thereafter**, Stewards from the Community Task Team will set up a meeting with his/her ward based **Church/management board** to discuss the introduction of the seven year plan.
5. The **“Collective Collaboration Community Platform”** (This platform will enable the local community to establish a local **Community Care Centre** for all the residents of the local community ward) to provide information to the Command Centre.
 - a. This **Community Care Centre** will act as a **Training Provider Facility** to the local Community and render **life skills combined with financial literacy training, financial products and services** to establish **and enable socio-economic activities, empowering Family Chest members.**
 - b. The first 10 Family Chests **then** register a Community Chest Trust **that** adheres to the requirements of and for governance in line with **local Government Structures.** **They agree** to completely **abide by the current established laws**, thus **allowing and enabling** the *local community* access to be employed in various projects within the community in **PPP partnership** with the local municipality.
 - c. The Community Chest Trust will appoint two (2) Community Ward Wealth Coaches from the Community banking platform as the Ward Financial Stewards to facilitate the financial processes for the ward to report to the CCCA National office.



- d. The **Community Chest** Wealth Coaches as facilitators of the Community Chest will facilitate the following Events / Training Sessions:
- i. **Collective Collaboration Community Platform** (Seven Year Plan) facilitation (SWOT/ Matrix) with the members of the local Community Chest in:
 1. *Re-aligning training for them to be effective Community Financial Change Agents.*
 2. *Developing a practical seven year plan to transform the local community by **establishing** goals and objectives **through** action plans in line with the generational inheritance message to leave a legacy for future generations on financial platforms including gold and silver.*
 3. *Appointing four Market Sector Stewards to facilitate the four sectors of the cross-subsidisation ward / county community co-operative financial institute & banking platform.*
 - ii. Installing a *sustainable* Local Community Care Centre as a *Training Centre* for the local family chest members, thus training new members on an *ongoing basis* in the following-:
 - iii. **Collective Collaboration Community Training;**
 1. **Class 101: Budgeting in Family and Community:** *Budgeting training for each individual by means of online Financial Literacy Training for budgeting and community chest shareholding banking platform.*
My Family Chest Benefits payroll card issued from Lisencing with Quality Bullion / Grobank.
 2. **Class 102: Living in Obedience:** *Focus on the Family support Counselling and Life Skills, ethics and mutual respect re-instated by means of an online educational platform building family lifestyle in obedience with financial empowerment strategies. Parenting with A.S.S.U.R.A.N.C.E training support course implemented.*
 3. **Class 103: Living in Victory:** *Developing your Personal Passion, Gifts and Style, teaching course members to compile a CV for successful employment strategies to be accepted based on your honesty and proof of competancies.*
 4. **Class 104: Living in Abundance:** *Growing Sons and Daughters on your shoulders **as you** transition from a steward to a mentor: **Trained** to be an effective Community Financial Change Agent for sustainable community chests development **in coming** out of debt and **remain** out of the financial slavery system that kept **and keeps** people poor and struggling; choose to be a winner, out of poverty and slavery.*
 5. **Class 105: Employable members will be trained** in the various Community Projects created from *sustainable models* by means of the CCCA's vision & mission for job creation or business development at Skills Villages **through** pre-approved vocational training sessions, entrepreneurial and co-operative workers platform.
6. CCCA meet with the MAYORAL COMMITTEE in every village, town and city (Community Chest to be accepted as a Mayoral Project, by the local government and municipality) to introduce Stewards from the **Community Ward Task Team** that will ensure data collection uploads to the **Community Command Centre**.
7. Set up first MAYORAL COMMITTEE COMMUNITY CHEST public meeting (with 24 community stewards) with the Mayor in conjunction with the Ward Wealth Coach and Community Chest Ambassador (town/city facilitator). The picture hereto is our Management Structure, not hierarchy.
8. This community chamber and collective collaboration project will be implemented in line with the currency redemption programme for 52 African countries to up-skill and uplift the African continent and islands.
9. Envisaged Projects for the African continent starting in South Africa will include; a) Currency Redemption underpinning with silver then gold standards, b) Eco-Energy-Enhancement, c) Community Communication Towers (not same as cell operators), d) Environmental Cleanup, e) Credit Unions, f) Job Creation.



Operational Programme include:

- a. Grade Camps participation will be held to test learners on budgeting with parents, to evaluate the Life Skills application per Grade of each school on the Enhanced Ecclesiastic Educational programme.
- b. Free Financial Literacy, Numeracy and various other products & services that will be introduced to enhance the abilities of Parents, Students and Teachers are already available from our Institute.
- c. Rapid Restoration Results processes will follow to enhance community transformation in the up-lifting of learners in conjunction with local family chest members, community structures and the media.
- d. Community Chest Circles Association will ensure sustainability of the Job Creation programme in conjunction with local government as well as the local business sectors and chambers to promote their products and services that will be distributed by collaboration teaming agreements.
- e. Collaboration between Family Chests, Community Chests, Community Stewards and Public Participation will enhance the local ward structures in and through the Collective Collaboration Community Training Platform for continuous and sustainable service delivery projects achieving and fulfilling the set goals and objectives of the 7 year development plan by each ward ensuring permanent establishment of every family's legacy for all future generations to follow, maintained and sustained by resolving legal issues that can be facilitated by means of Community Courts.
- f. Youth development by means of learnerships, internships and youth exchange programmes to various countries: we have consensus with June 16 Foundation to implement the new season of a "Youth Entrepreneurial Year" as a result of our CCCA platform with the Veteran Commission (all South African Council of Churches) and a military veteran association in collaboration with all.
